

Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1) **Who do I contact if I have questions regarding tuition assistance?**
The principal of the school in which your student is attending or planning on attending should be contacted with any questions.
- 2) **Where are the applications for tuition assistance located?**
*The applications are located on the website at:
www.choosecatholicshools.org or from the administrative staff at the school.*
- 3) **What is the deadline for the applications?**
March 31, 2010 – 1st deadline
(90% of funds awarded for applications submitted for this deadline)
July 31, 2010 – 2nd deadline
(10% of funds awarded for applications submitted for this deadline)
August 31, 2010 – new students only
- 4) **What is the typical amount of the scholarship?**
Scholarships awarded are based on a percentage of need for each individual family. The minimum/maximum amount awarded is \$500/\$2500.
- 5) **How do I qualify for tuition assistance?**
A PSAS application MUST be filled out and submitted in order to be considered for assistance. PSAS, a third party vendor, will do an assessment of the ability of each family to pay tuition.
- 6) **When will I be notified if I qualified for tuition assistance?**
May 1, 2010 – 1st set of award letters mailed
August 20, 2010 – 2nd set of award letters mailed
September 15, 2010 – 3rd set of award letter mailed – New students
- 7) **How many scholarships are available?**
In 2009-10, \$1.7M in scholarships was awarded to primary school students throughout the Archdiocese.
- 8) **Are there any other forms of tuition assistance available?**
Several schools have other scholarships available at the school level. Please contact the school for more information regarding tuition assistance.
